

# Construction, Motor Vehicle, Hair & Beauty & Creative Studies

## **Basic Construction:**

This is an applied course which is focused on developing hands-on skills in brick-laying, plastering and other areas of construction. This is a great opportunity for pupils hoping to enter the building profession. The course allows for progression to Level 2 but can also give students the necessary skills.

## **Motor Vehicle:**

This is an applied and vocational course on which pupils develop hands on skills in motor vehicle maintenance. The course is focused upon skills and knowledge required for working within the industry. It is an excellent opportunity to develop industry standard skills.

## **Hair and Beauty:**

This course is designed to provide a broad background of understanding the beauty sector and basic skills required. Pupils will study the following units:-

- Customer Service
- Basic Salon Reception Duties
- Personal Presentation
- Health and Safety Practice
- Applying Basic Make-up
- Providing Basic Manicure

## **Creative Studies Craft:**

This qualification is for learners who want to develop a broader understanding of Craft and how it can be applied in the vocational sector. Pupils will use various materials and develop ideas in response to a design brief. Typical materials to be explored, wood, ceramics, textiles, paint along with many other options. Pupils will be allowed to work to their strengths and respond to a brief accordingly. There are four units to be completed to build a portfolio of work.
